Responsibilities

The Bronc Athletic Club shall be recognized as a promotions and fundraising arm of the Athletic Department under the direction of the Athletic Director and the Assistant Athletic Director for Development.

Composition and Terms of Membership

Membership in the Bronc Athletic Club shall be open to any individual, business, or association that supports the Athletic Department as prescribed membership levels and shares the Department's mission, goals and objectives. Memberships shall be for one year, and shall commence generally on September 1 and expire August 31 of the following year. Members joining after September 1 shall have their membership commence immediately but also expire on August 31.

The Advisory Board shall be comprised of nine (9) members each appointed for a three-year term by the University President in accordance with University of Texas System rules. Three (3) members shall be appointed each year to assure overlapping terms. The president of each sport specific club will also be a member of the Advisory Board. Ex-officio non-voting members of the Advisory Board shall include the Athletic Director; the Assistant Athletic Director for Development; the Coordinator of Athletic Marketing; the University's NCAA Coordinator of Athletic Marketing; the University's NCAA Faculty Athletics Representative and the President of the Alumni Association. The Athletic Director may appoint other staff members as ex-officio members after consultation with the Board.

Reporting

The University Bronc Athletic Club reports to the President.
