Responsibilities

- Review, consider, and make recommendations on status reports on current campus facilities projects provided by the Director for Facilities Planning and Construction.
- Review, consider, and make recommendations on proposals for new construction, major renovation, significant alteration of space usage, or other campus modifications presented by the vice presidents or other appropriate administrator.
- Invite appropriate individuals to make presentations and respond to questions concerning proposed campus facilities projects.
- Review the annual update of the Campus Improvement Plan (CIP) prepared by the Director for Facilities Planning and Construction and recommend the priority order for campus facilities projects. The CIP will be submitted to the President for approval before being forwarded to The University of Texas System.
- Review and consider the following annual or biennial reports to inform campus development planning:
 - Agency Strategic Plan (Executive Director, Institutional Effectiveness)
 - Enrollment Projections (Executive Director, Institutional Effectiveness)
 - Facilities Inventory/Space Utilization Report (Deputy Director, Physical Plant)
 - Funding sources for Campus Facilities Projects (Vice President for Business Affairs/Vice President for External Affairs)
 - ADA Compliance Status Report (ADA Compliance Coordinator)
 - Technology Considerations (Director, Information Resources)
 - Parking and Traffic (Vice President for Business Affairs)
 - Student Opinion Survey Results (Vice President for Enrollment and Student Services)

Composition and Terms of Membership

The CFPC is composed of six regular members and six non-voting members designated by the President to represent the various divisions and campus facilities concerns of the institution as follows:

- Provost/Vice President for Academic Affairs (ex-officio, voting)
- Vice President for Business Affairs (ex-officio, voting)
- Vice President for Community Engagement (ex-officio, voting)
- Vice President for University Engagement (ex-officio, voting)
- Vice President for Enrollment and Student Services (ex-officio, voting)
- Vice President for Information Technology (ex-officio, voting)
- Chair, Faculty Senate (ex-officio, non-voting)
- Chair, Staff Senate (ex-officio, non-voting)
- President, Student Government Association (ex-officio, non-voting)
- Director, Information Resources (ex-officio, non-voting)
- Physical Plant Director for Facilities Planning and construction (ex-officio, non-voting)

- ADA Compliance Coordinator (ex-officio, non-voting)

Members of the CFPC continue to serve as long as the member holds the designated office.

Reporting

The CFPC reports to the President.
