Responsibilities

- Review and recommend policies for the approval and supervision of student organizations.
- Recommend the approval or denial of requests for student organizations for official recognition.
- Serve as a hearing body for organizations alleged to have violated University or Regents' policies, rules, or regulations as outlined in the Handbook of Operating Procedures, 6.5.1., Disciplinary Procedures for Student Organizations.

Composition and Terms of Membership

- 3 faculty members recommended by the Faculty Senate (voting)
- 1 administrator appointed by the Vice President (voting)
- 5 students appointed by the Student Government Association President (voting)
- Dean of Students (ex-officio, non-voting)

Faculty members are appointed to 3-year terms

Administrator is appointed to 3-year terms

Students are appointed for one year; students may be re-appointed to consecutive terms.

Reporting

The Committee on Student Organizations reports to the Vice President for Enrollment and Student Services.
